



THE MUNICIPAL OF THE VILLAGE OF HALKIRK, ALBERTA

Being a bylaw of the Village of Halkirk, in the Province of Alberta to establish rules, regulations and fees for the operation of all Halkirk Campgrounds.

WHEREAS Council of the Village of Halkirk, in the Province of Alberta, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the statutes of Alberta and amendments thereto may pass by-laws for the purpose of regulating and operating a municipal campground within the Village of Halkirk.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Village of Halkirk duly assembled enacts as follows:


1. The Village Chief Administrative Officer of the Village of Halkirk shall be responsible for the management of the Halkirk campgrounds in accordance with this Bylaw and the regulations regarding the campgrounds operations as established by the Council of the Village of Halkirk and by the Government of Alberta.
2. Regulations for the operation of the Halkirk Campgrounds are hereby adopted as outlined on Appendix "A" attached to this Bylaw. The Council of the Village of Halkirk may amend these regulations by resolution when it is deemed appropriate by the Council, without the need to repeal or amend this Bylaw.
3. The Bylaw Enforcement Officer, for the Village of Halkirk or a Peace Officer may enforce this Bylaw by such measures as deemed necessary to ensure the Bylaw is complied with, including the issuance of tickets or eviction from the campground as outlined herein.
4. The Bylaw Enforcement Officer, authorized by the Village Chief Administrative Officer, or a Peace Officer may evict an individual or group of individuals from the Halkirk Campgrounds if those individuals are creating a nuisance, or in breach of this Bylaw or its regulations, or if they are interfering with the quiet enjoyment of other campers.
5. (a) Any person contravening any provision of this Bylaw shall be liable upon conviction therefore to a fine of not less than \$500 and not more than \$1,000 exclusive of costs, in case of non-payment of the fine and plus costs so imposed; and


(b) Where the offence is non-payment of any camping fees as established by the regulation, the payment of the camping fee shall be in addition to the fines and penalties imposed. Fines and penalties are as defined in Bylaw No. 004 — 2022, the "Fees and Charges Bylaw."
6. This bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon receiving third and final reading.

Appendix "A"

Regulation for Operation of Village of Halkirk Operated Campgrounds & RV Campground

Please note: All regulations established under the Provincial Parks Act, Provincial Parks (General) Regulations apply to the lands set out in both Halkirk Provincial Recreation Area (PRA), Campgrounds and RV parks.

Violation of any of the below rules may result in a charge and/or eviction by a Village of Halkirk Employee, Bylaw Enforcement Officer, Peace Officer, or the RCMP.

Park Regulations Act:	Services are not for Communal use:
Drive Cautiously:	Children may be playing in the area and Campground roads are used as paths. Maximum speed is 20km/h.
Keep campsites clean:	Clean up all garbage, cans & food so that it does not attract animals and keeps the site neat and tidy.
Be careful with your campfire:	Your negligence could result in a destructive forest fire, Campfires are permitted in fireplaces only and must be attended at all times.
Enjoy your campfires here:	Firewood is only to be used on site and firewood is not provided for you.
Share the facilities:	Shower & Washrooms may not be used in such a way that limits use by others.
Be considerate of others:	All campers must refrain from rowdy behaviour and excessive noise. No generators between the hours of 22:00 P.M. and 08:00 A.M.
Control your pets:	To protect your pet, local wildlife and other campers, your pets must be on a leash during your stay.
Keep all vehicles on designated roads:	Trees and greenery are what beautifies the Campground. By wandering off roads, your vehicle kills plants and damages tree roots resulting in patches of bare soil. Off Highway vehicles may not be operated on the campground (a direct route from campground/staging area to designated trails that leads out of the Provincial Recreation Area may be created). Discharging firearms or the use of any weapon (knife, spear, bow and arrow, etc.) is strictly prohibited in all campground and within the Village boundaries.
Recreation areas are Not for shooting:	Firearms are to be unloaded and encased while in the Village of Halkirk Lake campgrounds / PRA's. Dressing, hanging or storing of big game shall not take place in the campground.
Use, but do not Abuse:	Enjoy the natural beauty and recreation facilities here, but please protect them for your next visit and for other campers.
Trails are provided for your enjoyment:	Stay on designated trails and use them only for the activity for which they are intended.
Equestrian users:	Horses are not allowed into the campground. Refer to <u>Bylaw No. 005 - 2022</u> .
Right of Entry:	Village of Halkirk employees, Peace Officer or RCMP may enter the premises and/or the property if it is deemed necessary to do so.
Fees	It is not permitted to have more than one (1) unit utilize any 01 the services provided (power, water, sewer). The Village may allow this to be overridden, however, there will be additional fees attached to this exception.
